



ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Prospective Residents are initially offered a day visit (free of charge), followed by a months trial period, to ensure that the home is able to meet individual clients needs.

In the event of a visit being impracticable, a visit to the Resident's own home can be arranged, to answer any queries and assess the type of individual care necessary.

VISITING

There is open visiting and visitors are asked to sign in and out.

LAUNDRY

Towels and bed linen are provided, Residents' personal clothing is laundered on the premises free of charge. All clothing must be marked with the Residents name and be machine washable.

QUALITY ASSURANCE

The home encourages the Residents to take an interest in the development of the services available to them within the residential home. Regular meetings are held between Residents and senior staff at the home, to enable the Residents to voice their opinions about the service.

INTRODUCTION

THE MANOR FARM HOUSE is an 18th Century farmhouse in Radstock just north of Somerset at the junctions of the A362 and A367 with Chew Valley Lakes and the Mendips to the west. Radstock, a former market town lies in a valley, with shops, banks, a Post Office, library, college, surgery, churches, splendid local museums and a good bus service only a few minutes walk away from the home. There is a local hospital in nearby Paulton where Bath specialists hold clinics.

The local bus service runs regularly to nearer towns such as Bath and Frome. The bus stop is only a few yards away from the home. Car service can be arranged for those unable to cope with public transport.

We are a happy and caring home, the emphasis being on home, with a 24 hour care team ready to look after the resident's needs, encourage and help them to be independent and generate new interests.

The current Manager and seniors are trained in areas such as Dementia, Palliative Care and diabetes. Most of the staff are trained in Medication, Food Hygiene, Health & Safety and First Aid & Fire. Staff at Manor Farm House have a flexible approach to meeting all your needs and to help you to retain your own privacy and to respect your every wish. Staff at Manor Farm House are available 24hrs a day.

The home accepts Social Services clients as well as self-funded clients.

MEALS

Meals may be taken in the dining room or the Residents bedroom according to personal preference and flexibility of meal times can be arranged.

FURNISHINGS

We will be pleased to provide furnishings where Residents are unable or do not wish to bring their own. There will be no extra charge for this.

Residents should feel free to bring selected items of furniture and personal possessions for their rooms and the proprietor will be happy to discuss this with prospective Residents.

Tasty, attractively presented meals are provided daily. Specific dietary needs are catered for and drinks are provided by the Staff on request, at any time day or night. Medical and other services

Residents may retain their own G.P. if local or arrangements can be made to register with a G.P. of their choice. Help with selection can be given to those Residents new to the area.

Manor Farm House has a visiting Chiropodist, Optician and Dentist. Residents retain their right to NHS facilities.

Visiting hairdresser, in-house beautician, newspaper and personal shopping services are available. Please speak to a member of staff if you require this to be set up.
